Lectured undergraduates in Structures (structural design, especially of structural steel) and Construction Technology. Lectured in Post Graduate Diploma and MSc Courses and set up and ran the very successful Post Graduate Diploma Course "Construction Law and Contract Administration" being its principal lecturer from its commencement in 1996. 1984 Consultancy Practice formed, principally in structural, geotechnical and marine engineering. Now solely specialising in Disputes Resolution.
Positions held	Member of Advisory Panel on Legal Affairs of the Institution of Civil Engineers (London) from 1998 to 2001. Chairman of Committee set up by IEI in about 1996 to draft a Design & Construct Contract – never published due to Government Construction Contracts Committee (GCCC) decision unilaterally to introduce its own forms of contract. Chairman of Sub-Committee set up by the Construction Industry Federation to draft forms of sub-contract, published in 2008, for use with the Public Works (GCCC) contracts. Currently chairing Sub-Committee to revise these sub-contracts to be compliant with the Construction Contracts Act 2103 and to update them.
Dispute resolution experience	One of the first practitioners in Alternative Disputes Resolution (ADR) in Ireland, conducting his first Conciliation of a construction dispute in 1988. Wide experience of both arbitration and conciliation of construction disputes both in civil engineering and building. His numerous Conciliations have, with only one exception, resolved the dispute, in the vast majority of cases by agreement between the parties. Sums in dispute have ranged from €35K to €30M. Now devoting his time exclusively to arbitration and conciliation/adjudication of construction disputes.
Specific areas of expertise	Civil engineering and building construction in general. Particular expertise in structural, geotechnical, road works, water services, marine/harbour works and tunneling. Also wide experience of building construction. Special knowledge of the IEI, RIAI, GDLA, FIDIC and Public Works (GCCC) forms and the various standard forms of sub-contract.
